

## MASTERS- COSTS FOR FINANCING STUDY AND STAY (NON-EEA students)

In relation to the application for an entry visa and/or residence permit for the purpose of study, the Dutch Immigration and Naturalization Service (IND) requires proof that you have sufficient funds to pay your tuition fee, support yourself during your entire stay in the Netherlands, and pay for relevant costs<sup>1</sup>. The costs for financing each master program are specified below:

*NB: Be aware of any transfer fees collected by the bank and include them in your total payment transfer. THUAS will not pay for these costs.*

### Deadline

Payments for NON-EEA applicants must be made **before June 15<sup>th</sup> 2021**.

The IND has determined a minimum of €897,56 per month, or €10.770,72 per year, as costs for living in the Netherlands- this includes housing, food, transportation, and health insurance. Because health insurance is covered in the applicable costs, what remains as proof of sufficient financial means is €10.086, which for the sake of convenience we will round off to €10.100.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

In order to participate in the master program of your choice, you must pay tuition fee, and in addition demonstrate that you have sufficient financial means to support yourself for one year in the Netherlands. You can choose how to do so via one, or a combination, of the following options. **Please note:** Applicants from “risk countries” as identified by the IND are required to choose option 1 in order to be admitted to the University.

### Option 1: Payment of package fee

The package fee payment covers all applicable costs, as well as €10.100 providing proof you have sufficient financial means to support yourself for one year in the Netherlands. The package fee for each master program is as follows:

- **MFMC** students: €30.658,-
- **MICM** students: €30.658,-
- **MBA** students: €32.597,-

After deduction of the applicable costs, €10.100 will be refunded to your (Dutch) bank account within 4 weeks after receiving the bank account details.

### Option 2: Payment of full tuition fee, health insurance and legal fees. Provide additional proof that you have sufficient financial means for one year in the Netherlands (€10.100)

For **MFMC** and **MICM** students payment is:

***You must then provide proof that you have sufficient financial means for one year’s stay in the Netherlands. You can do this by providing proof of one or more of the following<sup>2</sup>:***

- a. Money in your own bank account
- b. A financial guarantee abroad
- c. A financial guarantee in the Netherlands
- d. A company as a financial guarantee

**Option 3:** Payment of tuition fee in installments, health insurance and legal costs. Provide proof you have the remaining amount of the tuition fee PLUS sufficient means for one year in the Netherlands (€10.100)

For **MFMC**, **MICM** and **MBA** payment is:

The remaining tuition fee will be collected in 3 installments over the academic year and an **administrative fee of €500** will be spread out over these installments.

***You must then provide proof that you have the remaining tuition fee PLUS sufficient financial means for one year's stay in the Netherlands. You can do this by providing proof of one or more of the following:***

- e. Money in your own bank account
- f. A financial guarantee abroad
- g. A financial guarantee in the Netherlands
- h. A company as a financial guarantee

**Option 4:** You have been awarded a full expense scholarship

You must be in possession of a scholarship declaration. The declaration shows:

- The date
- The institution granting the scholarship
- The name of the scholarship program
- Your personal details (initials, surname, date of birth)
- The start and finish of the scholarship (start and end date)
- The amount you receive
